



## IWSHM - Stanford University 7<sup>th</sup> International Workshop on Structural Health Monitoring



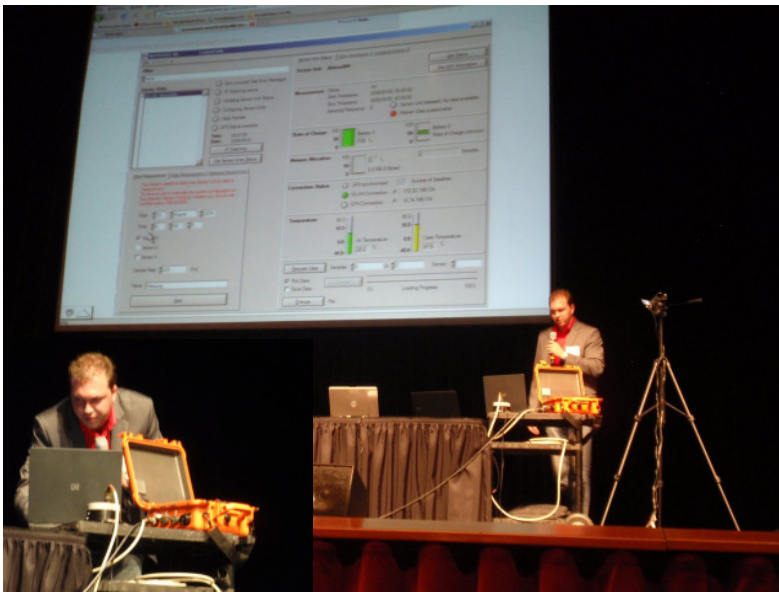
